Knowledge Test

We offer walk-in knowledge testing by appointment only, call to schedule your appointment time. If applicants are late, they must wait until the next scheduled test time. We are closed on holidays. If you have a Washington State ID card or Instruction permit you will need to bring it with you. Don't forget picture ID and birth certificate if you don't have valid ID. You do not need a parent/guardian to sign the policy procedure form. The test fee is \$35.00 and \$65.00 for the drive test. If you do not have a Washington State ID card complete the steps below before coming in to our office.

Age requirements

- 15-15½ years old
 - A Driving School of Gig Harbor will send a waiver electronically so you can get your permit.
 - Get your permit 1-10 days before you start your course. Holidays and weekends are included.
 - For example, if your course starts on the 20th of the month, you need to get your permit between the 10th and 19th.
- 15½ or older
 - If you're not signed up for a driver training course, or it's not within
 days of the start of the course you are enrolled in:
 - You'll need to pass the knowledge test before you can get your permit.

If you don't have a Washington ID card, follow these steps: (use quick link **preapply online**)

- 1. Go to the Department of Licensing website: <u>WWW.DOL.WA.GOV</u> CLICK ON: Get a driver license (under Drivers)
- 2. CLICK ON: Steps to getting your first license
- 3. CLICK ON: Instructions permit (Get an instruction (learners) permit to practice driving).
- 4. Pre-apply: Get my first Washington driver permit, license or ID card (Step 1 of 4). After you complete all 4 steps, you should receive an email with your Washington State confirmation #.
- 5. Now that you're enrolled at the Department of Licensing, email *A Driving School of Gig Harbor* your Washington Driver License (WDL) number to: enroll@a-driving-school.com

- 6. A Driving School of Gig Harbor Inc. will complete an electronic waiver so you can apply for a permit without taking the knowledge test.
- 7. Things you will need to bring to the Department of Licensing:
 - Birth certificate
 - Know your Social Security #
 - Glasses or contacts (if needed)
 - A parent/ legal guardian
 - \$25
